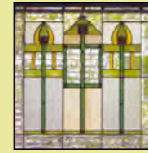
## EASY...

## SIMPLE...

• No complex formulas or separate categories for people or groups. Just choose the category that reflects the amount you'd like to donate.



## YOUR WINDOW OF OPPORTUNITY...

**CLERESTORY** \$35

(A band of narrow windows close to the ceiling or roof line, usually located for both light and ventilation.)

**ORIEL** \$50

(A window that projects from the wall but does not reach the ground; usually supported by brackets or corbels.)

**BAY** \$100

(A window or set of windows projecting from the outside wall, creating a recess within.)

**JALOUSIE** \$250

(A window with parallel glass louvers set in a frame; can be opened, usually with a crank, to control airflow.)

**QUATREFOIL** \$500

(A round window composed of four equal lobes, like a four-petaled flower. Often seen in Gothic architecture.)

**PALLADIAN** \$1000

(A large window divided into 3 parts. The center section is larger than the two side sections, and is usually arched.)
